Scholarship Program



The program will distribute scholarships of \$500 to students that have received a previous scholarship; whose parents or grandparents are still AFSCME members in good standing with continuous, uninterrupted membership. Considered in the selection process will be the applicant's family's financial status, any hardships that affect him/her, other scholarships received, and any community, religious, or union service which has been demonstrated. Scholarships will be available for both colleges and universities or vocational schools. Each applicant will also be required to submit three references, which may be contacted by the reviewing body. Upon reviewing the applications, interviews with qualifying applicants may be conducted.

INSTRUCTIONS

Any high school senior or any previous reward student in undergraduate school and fulfills the following requirements is eligible for apply for the scholarship:

- a. The student must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0 or above.
- b. The student must show proof that they will be attending school no later than fall of the current year.
- c. The student must be the son or daughter, grandson or granddaughter of an AFSCME member in good standing for a minimum of one year.

TO APPLY

1. Complete the applicant's section.
2. Have your parent or grandparent complete the member's section on the reverse side.
3. Attach a copy of your parent's/grandparent's financial status (whomever is a member).
4. Make sure your completed application is mailed to AFSCME 962 with all pertinent information.
